Daniela Astone

Daniela Astone (b. 1980 Pisa) grew up in the sea-town of Porto Santo Stefano, Italy. Her formal artistic training started at the age of 14 in the High School of Arts in Grosseto.

After graduating in 1998, she moved to Florence to study Illustration at the International School of Comics. In her second year, she began working independently for several editors and for the illustration studio inkLink.

At the age of 21, Daniela decided to change direction and to re-start studying drawing and painting from life at The Florence Academy of Art under the direction of Daniel Graves.

She began teaching the younger students at the Academy when she was in her second year. She graduated in 2004 and received the end of year award. She continues to work as one of the main teachers of the Florence Academy of Art.

In 2005, she had her first and a very successful solo show at the Ann Long Fine Art Gallery in Charleston. After the show, she built a studio in the Tuscany countryside.

In 2013, Daniela became the Director of the Intermediate Program at The Florence Academy of Art, entered in the BP Award in London and received an Honorable Mention from the Mod Portrait Award, Spain.

Her work has been exhibited internationally, and in 2016, it became part of the permanent collection of MACS, the Contemporary Art Museum in Sicily.

She has collaborated with Tiac (China), Liveandlearn (Thailand), Streamline, and East Oaks Studio. She teaches landscape painting workshops in her studio-house in Chianti Tuscany and around the world.

In 2019, together with Gaia Grazioli, she curated the Show "Corpo a Corpo" in the Museum of Villa Bardini in Florence, thanks to Cassa di Risparmio di Firenze and Carlo Sisi.

In 2022, Daniela left the position of Director at the Florence Academy of Art to dedicate herself full-time to her studio production.
